8. What advice would you give someone entering the industry?
9. What skills would I need to be successful in this position?
10. How long has the position been vacant?
11. What is the corporate atmosphere/culture like?
12. What would a day on the job be like?
13. Who would be my coworkers and what would they be like?
14. What is the dress code?
15. Where do you see the organization in the next five to ten years?
16. When will a decision be made about who will get the job offer?
17. Will you notify me? Or even better May I contact you later?
18. Can I provide you will any relevant information in the future?
19. Who will I be reporting to? What are they like?
20. How long is the training process? How will I be evaluated?
21. Is travel required for this position?
22. What is the housing like in the geographical area I will be working?
23. Where does this position fit in the organizational structure?
